



CCF Membership Meeting Minutes 11/29/2025

- President Jim Brazeal
 - Runway Improvement – The plan is to spread asphalt millings then smooth and compact them. We expect some settling even after being compacted, so we will smooth them again as needed. Once they are set and we don't have any more settling (which could take several months), we will cover the runway with the asphalt driveway repair coating to lock it in place. This will basically make it look and act like asphalt and should last quite a few years since all that is going to be on it is foot traffic and R/C planes. The field will remain open for flying while we are upgrading the runway except for times when we are actually on the runway doing work.
 - Runway approval update – We are still awaiting approval from the state/county to start runway repairs. Evidently there were some storm water drainage calculations that were required. Jim has been in weekly contact with the county and will follow-up again next week. **(Post Meeting Update – On 12/2/2025 CCF received written permission to proceed with this project.)**
 - The club has received around \$9000 in donations/pledges towards repairs so combined with the money in our accounts, we have funding available to start the project.
- VP Dale Schock – Proposed a “seasonal membership” for people who are only in Florida part-time. Seasonal members would only pay ½ dues but would be non-voting and limited to four months flying per year. The meeting attendees were in favor of this so Secretary Mark will draft a proposed Bylaws update for approval at a future meeting.
- Training Coordinator Rex Hall – Provided a training update and outlined the AMA’s Introductory Pilot Program. Under this program, perspective members may fly under the guidance of designated Introductory Pilot Mentor (IPM) prior to joining the AMA. Contact Rex if interested in becoming an IPM.
