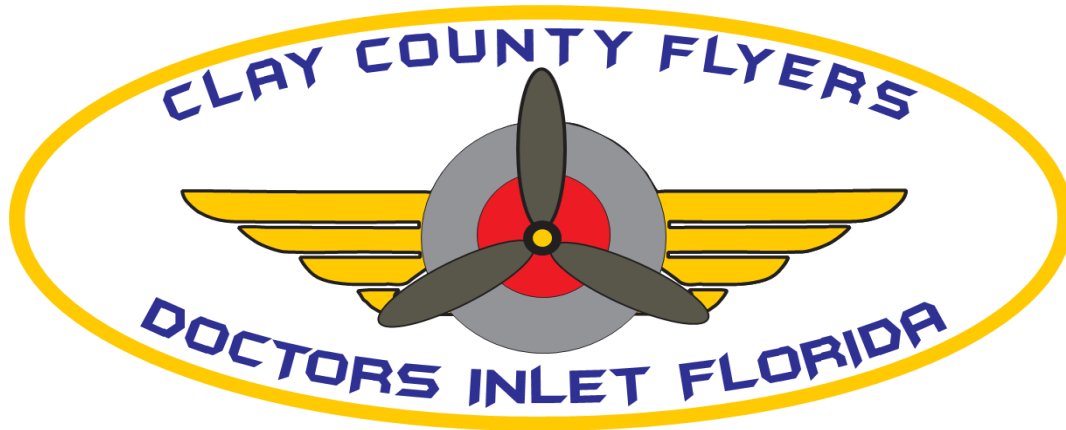




CCF Membership Meeting Minutes 02/28/2026

- Bylaws Update Approval – Club membership voted to approve two changes to our Bylaws.
 - Establishment of a Seasonal Membership Classification
 - Seasonal Member – Is a member who does not permanently live within 100 miles of the club. Seasonal Members may use the club facilities an unlimited number of times during any four months of the calendar year. These months need not be contiguous. Seasonal members must be eighteen (18) years of age or older, hold a current AMA membership and will not have voting rights. Dues for Seasonal Members will be one half Full Membership Dues or one half of the Military Dues as applicable.
 - Removal of requirement to have a club sticker on AMA cards because we no longer use stickers.
 - AMA Membership Cards: Club members and guests who are flying RC aircraft must be able to display a valid AMA membership card upon request by either Clay County personnel or Club Officers.
- Runway Update – The runway continues to be a work in progress. At this time the runway is mostly level, but the surface smoothness is not good enough for aircraft with smaller wheels. Our efforts have been hampered by two issues. First, the millings that we purchased ended up being more course than we expected. Secondly, the surface of the landfill cap is much less firm than expected. There was a lengthy discussion regarding possible future actions which included a commercial estimate (obtained by VP Matt) of \$15k-\$20k for an additional 8-10 truck loads of double crushed millings followed by bulldozer leveling then sealing. Viability of that plan was discussed, which included concerns regarding our ability to raise that much money and use of heavy equipment on the soft landfill cap. As of now, the plan is to continue leveling work with the existing millings followed by another rolling. The pace of our work is limited by the time that our equipment operator (President Jim) can volunteer to this project.
